**Starting Line:**

Between CPA Red Lateral Mark HUN 3, and an orange flag on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag moored adjacent. HUN3 to be left to PORT

**Course:**

From **TOMONT END** to **WEMYSS BAY**, leaving the Committee Vessel to STARBOARD, GREAT CUMBRAE, PORTACHUR SPIT BUOY No38, and TOWARD BANK No35 to STARBOARD, green CPA Buoy SKELMORLIE BANK (No 32) to PORT, CPA Yellow Mark 'N' and CPA Green Lateral Mark 'O' to STBD, CPA Red Lateral Mark 'L' to PORT.

Distance: 19 Nautical Miles

**Finishing Line:**

Finishing yachts should pass CPA Red Lateral Mark 'L' to PORT within four boat lengths, the Finish Line being a line perpendicular to the course from the last Mark, Mark 'O'. No Committee Vessel will be on station. Yachts should record their own finish time and where appropriate, the name of yachts ahead and astern.

**Time Limit:**

The time limit will be 17.30 hrs

**Conditions:**

The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions will apply.

**Members are reminded that the Upper Firth is busy with Ferries and Naval and Commercial Vessels. Members must be aware of Clydeport Regulations as detailed in their publication 'CLYDE LEISURE NAVIGATION GUIDE' 5th edition, available as a download from [www.fairlieyachtclub.org.uk](http://www.fairlieyachtclub.org.uk), or directly from the Peelports/Clydeport website**
