START The Start line will be between Red, Yellow and Black/Orange Buoys to the North of Kip Marina entrance. Red or Yellow pin to be left to Port or Stbd. in accordance with the course set.

COURSES There will be eight courses. Lengths vary to suit prevailing wind conditions. Mark sequence is listed on p19. Course selection will be announced on VHF Ch77 or by hail. In fresh conditions, more than one round may be sailed.

FINISH Same line as the Start with first boat over line as winner. In the event of no finishers by 2100, the first boat round the last completed mark will be the winner.

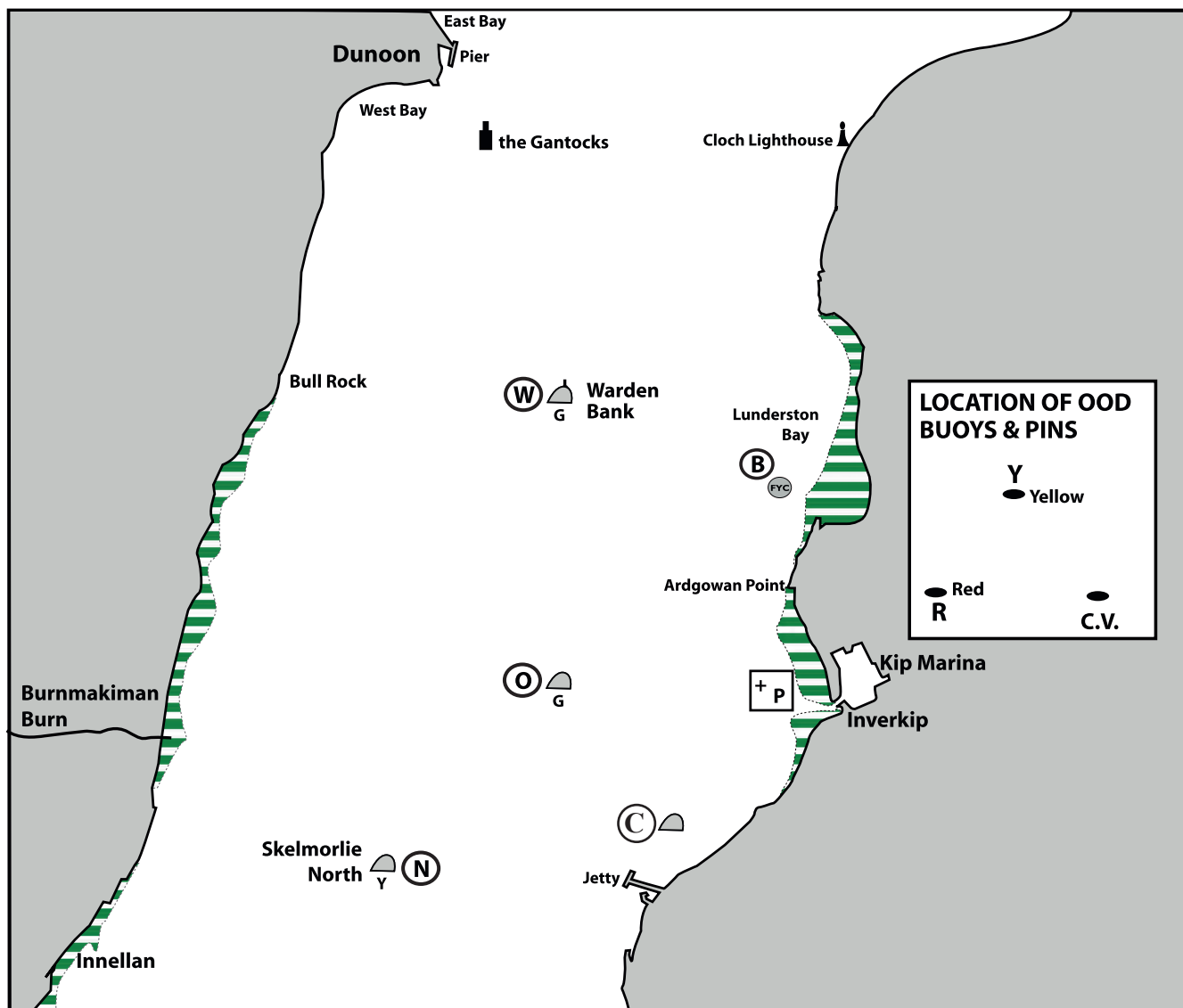
CLASSES All yachts shall sail in one Restricted Sail Class. (Subject to demand and numbers, the Committee may introduce Class 1 - Spinnaker, Class 2 - Restricted Sail.)

SERIES There will be 3 series of six races with best four results in each series counting. A minimum of two boats is required in a Class for the race to count.

ELIGIBILITY Racing will be open to both FYC Members and Non-Members. All boats must have a CYCA Handicap and 3rd party Racing Risks Insurance cover.

RACE FEE No Fee for FYC Members.
A £10 fee per series for Non-Members, which is refundable if joining the Club

Amendment to Sailing Instructions No 1/2020

Kip Pursuit Races – Series 3

The third series of Kip Pursuit Races will commence on Wednesday, July 22. Details can be found on Pages 18 and 19 of the 2020 Yearbook, with the following Amendment:

START: The normal start grid has not been laid. A single red FYC mark is on station to the north of Kip entrance.

Starting yachts should pass within two boat lengths of the red mark at the start time appropriate to their handicap, listed in the table on p18 of the Yearbook. A line perpendicular to the track to the first mark of the course shall constitute the start line.

FINISH: As above, finishing yachts should pass within two boat lengths of the red FYC mark, a line perpendicular to the track from the previous mark shall constitute the finishing line.

Competing yachts must comply with the prevailing COVID-19 restrictions as intimated by the Scottish Government at the time of each race in the series. In

particular, crew complement and social distancing must be considered before participating.

No club organised social gathering will be possible after racing, until such times as restrictions are sufficiently relaxed.
