START The Start line will be between Red, Yellow and Black Buoys to the North of Kip Marina entrance. Red or Yellow pin to be left to Port or Stbd. in accordance with the course set.

COURSES There will be eight courses. Lengths vary to suit prevailing wind conditions
Mark sequence is listed on p21. Course selection will be announced on VHF Ch77 or by hail. In fresh conditions, more than one round may be sailed.

FINISH Same line as the Start with first boat over line as winner. In the event of no finishers by 2100, the first boat round the last completed mark shall be the winner.

CLASSES Yachts shall sail in two Classes. Class (Pennant) 1 - Spinnaker, Class (Pennant) 2 - Restricted Sail. A minimum of 2 yachts is required in each Class to count as a race.

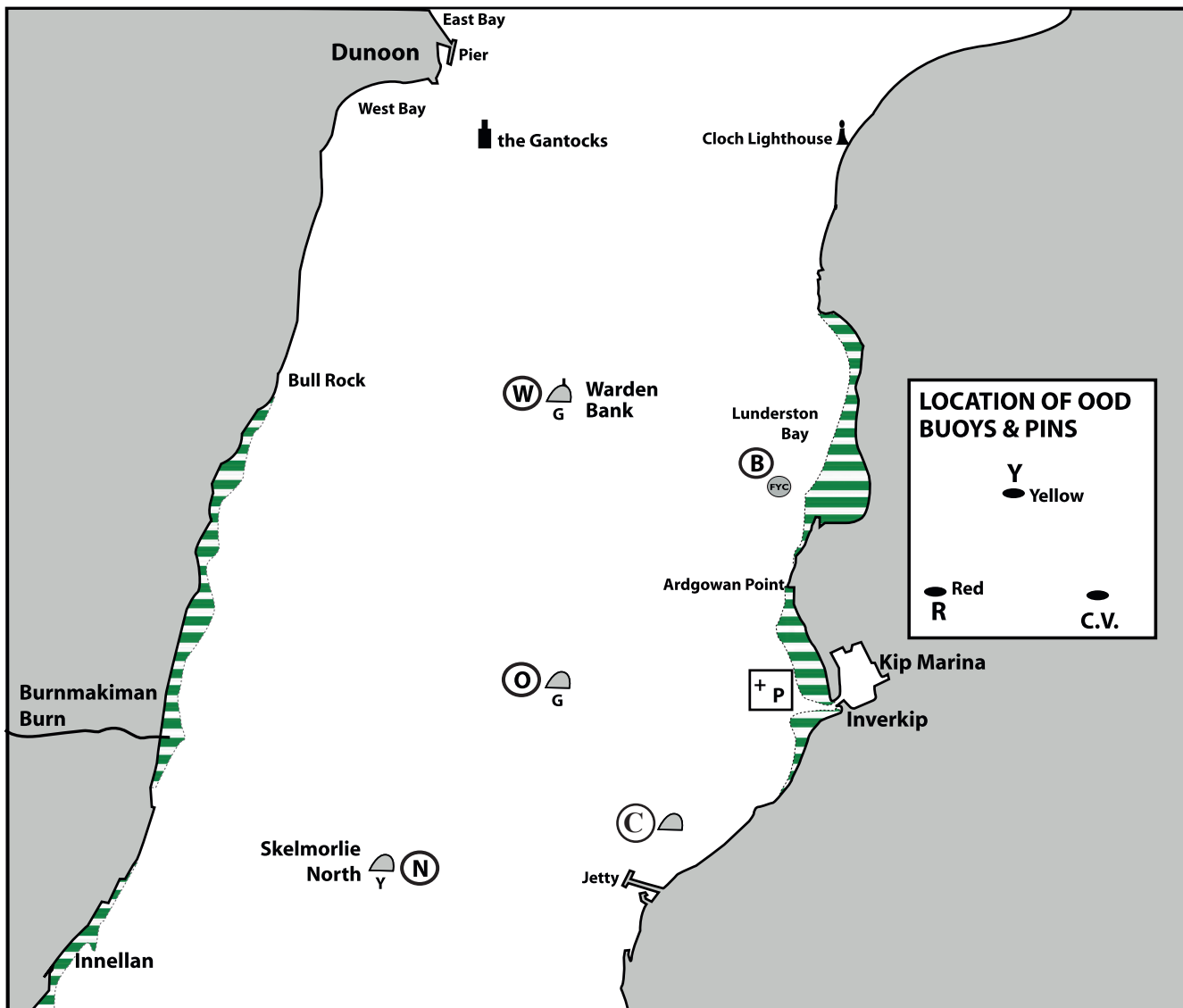
SERIES There will be three series of six races with best four results in each series counting.

**A Crews' Race will be sailed on July 21, between Series 2 and 3.
Yachts shall be helmed by a crew member who is not a regular helm.**

ELIGIBILITY Racing will be open to both FYC Members and Non-Members.
All boats shall have a CYCA Handicap and 3rd party Racing Risks Insurance cover.

RACE FEE No Fee for FYC Members.
A £10 fee per series for Non-Members, which is refundable if joining the Club.
