Starting Line:

Between an orange pennant on a Committee Vessel moored to a Yellow Admiralty Mooring (N5551.4 W00502.9), and an inflatable yellow buoy. A CV will be in attendance.

Courses:

The course, either 'north-about' or 'south-about' the island, will be indicated by a board displayed on the Committee Vessel. (The decision on which course to sail, will be taken about one hour before the start).

A Red Disc will indicate a 'north-about' course.

A Green Disc will indicate a 'south-about' course.

Full course details are published in the Sailing Instructions, downloadable from the FYC website, from the Club Secretary, or IBSC.

This includes information on shortened course timings and procedures.

Finish:

Between a large yellow inflatable outer mark, and an orange buoy inshore, off the IBSC Clubhouse. The orange buoy should be left to Starboard

Time Limit: 1900 hrs

Conditions: Racing will be in accordance with ISAF Rules of Racing 2017 – 2020

Handicap splits are detailed in the Sailing Instructions. All competing yachts must display a class flag.

A Race Fee of £25 is payable to IBSC by 1st June 2017. Late Entry Fee of £30.00 is payable until 23rd June 2017. NO entries on day.

Trophies and Prizes:

There will be trophies for the first in each class, and prizes for the second in each class. The boat with the fastest overall corrected time will be presented with the Marquis of Bute Trophy, which must remain in the Club House. The highest placed 'Bute Boat' will be awarded a trophy.

In addition to the above, the fastest FYC boat on corrected time will receive a FYC Trophy
