Starting Line:

Between Fairlie Racing Mark (R) off **KIP MARINA**, and a staff flying an orange pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag, moored adjacent.

Course:

From KIP to HOLY LOCH, leaving CPA GREEN BUOY 'O' to STBD, FYC Race Mark 'B' (LUNDERSTON BAY) to PORT, KILCREGGAN No2 (Red), ARDMORE No4 (Red), ARDMORE No8 (Red), SUGARSHIP WEST CARDINAL BUOY, and CPA RED BUOY No27 (South of Rosneath Patch) all to STBD.

Finish: A line between a staff flying a blue pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a red FYC flag moored North of the Western Ferries pier at HUNTERS QUAY, and the South Cardinal Mark at STRONE POINT.

(In the event of the Committee Vessel not being on station, yachts should note their time and finishing position as they cross a line between the Western Ferries Pier and the South Cardinal Mark at STRONE POINT.)

Time Limit: The time limit for all classes shall be 1700 hrs with a half hour extension for any Class where a yacht of that Class has finished before 1700.

Conditions: The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions will apply.

Members are reminded that the Upper Firth is busy with Ferries and Naval and Commercial Vessels.
