Starting Line:

Between Fairlie Racing Mark 'K' off Largs Yacht Haven, and a staff flying an orange pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag moored adjacent.

Course:

From **FAIRLIE** to **PORT BANNATYNE**, leaving the Committee Vessel to STARBOARD, Red CPA Buoy 'Hun 3' (TOMONT) to STARBOARD, green CPA Buoy SKELMORLIE BANK (No 32) to PORT, TOWARD BANK BUOY (No 35, green) to PORT, and the ASCOG PATCHES BEACON to STARBOARD

Finishing Line:

Between the green ARDYNE POINT Buoy, and a staff flying a blue pennant on a COMMITTEE VESSEL displaying a Red FYC flag, stationed off ARDBEG POINT, the Committee Vessel to be left to PORT.

(In the event of the Committee Vessel not being on station, Competitors should record their own finish times using a line between the northern tip of Port Bannatyne Marina Breakwater, and the Ardyne Point Buoy)

Time Limit:

The time limit shall be 17.00 hrs, with a half hour extension for any Class when a yacht of that Class has finished before 17.00.

Conditions: The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions will apply

Members are reminded that the Upper Firth is busy with Ferries and Naval and Commercial Vessels.
