

Passage Race Series

Start: High Water Greenock: 0947 BST

Times:	Time Signal	10.30	Orange Start Pennant Hoisted
Classes 1, 2, 4	Warning Signal	10.35	Pennant 1, 2 and 4 Hoisted
Classes 1, 2, 4	Prepare Signal	10.36	Code Flag 'P' Hoisted

Starting Line:

Between Fairlie Racing Mark 'K' off Largs Yacht Haven, and a staff flying an orange pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag moored adjacent.

Courses:

A) From FAIRLIE to KAMES, via the TANN, GARROCH HEAD and the WEST KYLE, leaving the Committee Vessel to PORT, the PORTACHUR SPIT BUOY (CPA 38), BUTE, INCHMARNOCK, and the ARDLAMONT RED LATERAL BUOY (No 47) to STBD.

B) (Heavy Weather Alternative)

From FAIRLIE to TIGHNABRUAICH, via the East Kyle, leaving the Committee Vessel to STBD, the ARDYNE POINT BUOY to STBD, ARDMALEISH BUOY (No 41) and RHUBODOCH BUOY to PORT, and the RHUBHABAN BUOY to STBD.

Finish: COURSE A: Between a staff flying a blue pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag, moored adjacent to the Kames Hotel, and an inflatable racing mark anchored approximately 200 metres off the stone pier, the CV to be left to PORT.

In the event of the Committee Vessel and inflatable mark not being on station, Competitors should record their own finish times and position relative to other finishers when the Northern face of the stone pier adjacent to the Kames Hotel bears 260deg. A smart phone photo of the pier, taken at the Finish, will assist the Race Committee in compiling the results.

COURSE B: Between the Western face of Tighnabruaich Pier and a staff flying a blue pennant on a Committee Vessel moored in Blackfarland Bay. The CV to be left to Port.

In the event of the Committee Vessel not being on station, Competitors should record their own finish time and position relative to other finishers when the Western face of Tighnabruaich Pier bears 330 deg. A smart phone photo of the pier, taken at the Finish, will assist the Race Committee in compiling the results

Time Limit:

The time limit for all classes shall be 17.00 hrs with a half hour extension for any Class where a yacht of that Class has finished before 17.00 hrs.

Conditions:

The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions will apply.

Social Arrangements

Yachts should moor off The Kames Hotel.

There will be a muster on the beach at 1830, the Club will provide refreshments.

A Club Supper will be served in the Kames Hotel at 1930, followed by further entertainment tha Reservations will be required for the meal in the Hotel.
