**Starting Line:**

Between the green ARDYNE POINT BUOY, and a staff flying an orange pennant on a Committee Vessel, displaying a Red FYC flag, moored off Ardbeg Point.

**Courses:**

From **PORT BANNATYNE** to **SKELMORLIE**, leaving the Committee Vessel to STBD, TOWARD BANK BUOY to PORT, Skelmorlie Channel Red LATERAL BUOY 'J' to STBD, ASCOG PATCHES BEACON to PORT, Skelmorlie Channel Green LATERAL BUOY 'I' to STBD

**Finish:**

Finishing Yachts shall record their own finishing time as SKELMORLIE Channel Green LATERAL BUOY 'I' bears 180deg, within three boat lengths.  
*A smart phone photo of the buoy at the finish will assist the Race Committee in verifying the results. Times and photos should be emailed to the Club Secretary or posted on the IPRS Whatsapp chat.*

**Time Limit:** The time limit shall be 15.00 hrs, with a half hour extension for any Class when a yacht of that Class has finished before 15.00.

**Conditions:** The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions will apply.
