*Individual Class Starts may be adopted if justified by the number of competing yachts in the Start area.
Look out for Flag L on the Committee Vessel and monitor VHF Ch77*

Starting Line:

Between Fairlie Racing Mark (R) off KIP MARINA, and an orange flag on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag, moored adjacent.

Course:

From KIP to STRONE PT., leaving WARDEN BANK CPA LATERAL BUOY (Green), KILCREGGAN No2 (Red), ARDMORE No4 (Red), ARDMORE No10 (Red), NATO MOORING BUOYA8 (Yellow, N55°57.9 W004°45.9), CPA RED LATERAL BUOY No 27 all to STBD, KILCREGGAN No1(Green) to PORT and STRONE POINT CARDINAL MARK No30 to STBD

Finish: Finishing yachts should record their own finish time when the STRONE POINT South Cardinal Mark (No 30), bears 030°m, within three boat lengths. A smart phone photograph of the mark at the finish and the names of yachts finishing ahead and behind may assist the Committee in verifying the results

Time Limit:

The time limit for all classes shall be 1700 hrs with a half hour extension for any Class where a yacht of that Class has finished before 1700.

Conditions: RRS 2025-2028 apply.

FYC's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions shall also apply to FYC yachts.

Members are reminded that the Upper Firth is busy with Ferries, Naval and Commercial Vessels. Members must be aware of regulations and good practice as detailed in the Peel Ports, Clydeport Website: <https://www.peelports.com/marine/our-ports/clydeport>
