**Starting Line:**

Between Fairlie Racing Mark 'K' off Largs Yacht Haven, and an orange flag on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag moored adjacent.

**Courses:**

The Course will be indicated by an alphabetical letter displayed from the Committee Vessel.

**A:** From **FAIRLIE** to **TIGHNABRUAICH** via the TANN and the WEST KYLE, leaving the PORTACHUR SPIT CARDINAL BUOY (CPA38), INCHMARNOCK and ARDLAMONT CARDINAL BUOY (CPA47) to STARBOARD

**B:** From **FAIRLIE** to **TIGHNABRUAICH** via the EAST KYLE, leaving GREAT CUMBRAE to PORT, HUN 3, RED LATERAL BUOY D, and ASCOG PATCHES (CPA13) to STARBOARD, BOGANY PT BUOY (No 36), ARDMALEISH BUOY (No 41), and RHUBODOCH BUOY to PORT, and RHUBHABAN BUOY to STARBOARD

**Finish:**

Between a blue flag on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag, moored in or adjacent to BLACKFARLAND BAY on BUTE, and the Western end of the face of TIGHNABRUAICH PIER (or Western End of a vessel if tied up at the pier.) In the event of no Committee Vessel being on station, Competitors should record their own finish times when the Western end of Tighnabruaich Pier bears 310°m within 100 metres of the pier.

**Time Limit:**

The time limit for all classes will be 17.00 hrs with a half hour extension for any Class where a yacht of that Class has finished before 17.00 hrs.

**Conditions:**

The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions will apply.

*Members are reminded that the Upper Firth is busy with Ferries and Naval and Commercial Vessels.
