START:

Starting Line:

Between Fairlie Racing Mark 'K' off Largs Yacht Haven, and an orange flag on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag moored adjacent.

Course:

From **FAIRLIE** to **ROTHESAY**, leaving the Committee Vessel to STARBOARD, Red CPA Buoy 'Hun 3' (TOMONT) to STARBOARD, green CPA Buoy SKELMORLIE BANK (No 32) to PORT, TOWARD BANK BUOY (NO35, green) to PORT, ASCOG PATCHES BEACON to STARBOARD, BOGANY POINT BUOY (CPA36) and ADMIRALTY MOORING BUOY (N55°51.4 W005°02.9) to PORT

Finishing Line:

Between an Orange Buoy moored off IoBSC Clubhouse, and a blue flag on a staff at the Northern end of the Clubhouse, the orange buoy to be left to port.

(In the event of the orange buoy not being on station, competitors should record their own finish times when the Northern end of the Clubhouse bears 270°m within 100m of the shore)

Time Limit:

The time limit will be 17.00hrs

Conditions:

The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions will apply.

Members are reminded that the Upper Firth is busy with Ferries and Naval and Commercial Vessels. Members must be aware of regulations and good practice as detailed in the Peel Ports, Clydeport Website.
