START The Start line will be between Red, Yellow and Black/Orange Buoys to the North of Kip Marina entrance. Red or Yellow pin to be left to Port or Stbd., in accordance with the first track of the course set. Start times MUST be taken from a smart phone or GPS for consistency.

COURSES There are 16 suggested courses. Lengths vary to suit prevailing wind conditions.

Mark sequence is listed on p19. ROs may also create other courses to suit prevailing conditions. Course selection will be announced on VHF Ch77 or by hail. In fresh conditions, more than one round may be sailed

FINISH Same line as the Start with first boat over line as winner. In the event of no finishers by

2100, the first boat round the last mark passed by all the fleet shall be the winner.

CLASSES Racing will be in one restricted sail class. With sufficient demand, a second (spinnaker)

class will be permitted by agreement with the Race Committee.

SERIES There will be three series of six races with best four results in each series counting.

A Crews' Race will be sailed on July 16, between Series 2 and 3. Yachts shall be helmed by a crew member who is not a regular helm.

ELIGIBILITY Racing will be open to both FYC Members and Non-Members.

All boats shall have a CYCA Handicap and 3rd party Racing Risks Insurance cover.
