Starting Line:

Between FYC Pin Mark (Y) off **KIP MARINA**, and a staff flying an orange pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag, moored adjacent.

Course:

From KIP to STRONE PT., leaving WARDEN BANK, CPA GREEN BUOY, KILCREGGAN No2 (Red), ARDMORE No4 (Red), ARDMORE No8 (Red), SUGARSHIP WEST CARDINAL BUOY all to STBD, CPA RED LATERAL BUOY No 27 and STRONE POINT CARDINAL MARK No30 to STBD

Finish:

Finishing yachts should record their own finish time when the **STRONE POINT** South Cardinal Mark (No 30), bears 030 deg M., within three boat lengths. A smart phone photograph of the mark at the finish and the names of yachts finishing ahead and behind may assist the Committee in verifying the results

Time Limit:

The time limit for all classes shall be 1700 hrs with a half hour extension for any Class where a yacht of that Class has finished before 1700.

Conditions: The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions shall apply.

Members are reminded that the Upper Firth is busy with Ferries and Naval and Commercial Vessels. Members must be aware of regulations and good practice as detailed in the Peel Ports, Clydeport Website.
