**Starting Line:**

Between Fairlie Racing Mark 'K' off Largs Yacht Haven, and a staff flying an orange pennant on a Committee Vessel displaying a Red FYC flag, moored adjacent

**Courses:**

From FAIRLIE to LAMLASH, leaving the Committee Vessel to PORT, GREAT CUMBRAE and LITTLE CUMBRAE to STBD, RED LATERAL BUOY, 0.3nm South of HAMILTON ROCK to STBD

**Finish:**

Yachts shall record their own finishing time as the HAMILTON ROCK red lateral buoy bears 290degM, within three boat lengths, along with the names of yachts finishing ahead and astern. A smart phone photo of the buoy at the finish will assist the Race Committee in verifying the results.

**Time Limit:**

The time limit shall be 17.00hrs, with a half hour extension for any Class when a yacht of that Class has finished before 17.00.

**Conditions:**

The Club's Standing Orders and Sailing Instructions will apply.

**Mooring**

It has been reported that only 5 visitor moorings are available this season
